

RESOLUTION NO. 08-034

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF DEER TRAIL DRIVE,
FAWN HILL ROAD, ORCHARD VIEW DRIVE (NORTH)
AND ORCHARD VIEW DRIVE (SOUTH)**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2316 of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. Section 67316, the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township may, by Resolution, accept any land dedicated by deed to the Township to be used as a road, street, or alley; and

WHEREAS, Test Enterprises, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation joined by Summit Ridge Homeowners Association, a Pennsylvania not for profit corporation, has offered to Berwick Township certain roads as shown on the "Street Dedication Plat, Summit Ridge" dated May 19, 2008, prepared by Sharrah Design Group, Inc., and known as Deer Trial Drive, Fawn Hill Road, Orchard View Drive (North) and Orchard View Drive (South).

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township, pursuant to its authority under the Second Class Township Code, finds that it is necessary for the promotion of the public good and welfare of the Township to accept a dedication of the aforesaid roads for public use;


NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township **RESOLVE** as follows:

1. The roadways known as Deer Trial Drive, Fawn Hill Road, Orchard View Drive (North) and Orchard View Drive (South) more particularly described in a Deed of Dedication from Test Enterprises, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation joined by Summit Ridge Homeowners Association, a Pennsylvania not for profit corporation, to Berwick Township, dated July 19, 2008, are hereby accepted as public roads of Berwick Township. A true and correct copy of aforesaid Deed of Dedication is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".


