

BERWICK TOWNSHIP, ADAMS COUNTY

RESOLUTION NO. 11-025

Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the Berwick Township, Adams County, is vulnerable to natural hazards like flooding, wind and weather hazards, drought, earthquakes, wildfires, landslides, and human-caused hazards that can result in property loss, loss of life, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety.

WHEREAS, an Adams County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan has been developed by Adams County Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee and the people of the county.

WHEREAS, the Adams County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by the natural hazards that face Berwick Township, and

WHEREAS, a series of public meetings were held to develop and review the plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of supervisors of Berwick Township that:

- The Adams County Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of Berwick Township.
- By September 30th of each year, the Adams County Hazard Mitigation Planning committee shall prepare an annual evaluation report to the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township.
- The respective Berwick Township officials and agencies identified in the strategy of the Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them. They will consult semi-annually with the Adams County Hazard Mitigation Planning Committee on the progress of their Activities.
