RESOLUTION NO. 11-027

Upon motion duly made, seconded, and unanimously carried, the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 1902 of Act 57 of May 15, 1998, (Title 62 Pa C.S. 1902), known as the "Commonwealth Procurement Code" permitting local public procurement units, local municipalities, and authorities to sponsor, establish, participate in, conduct, or administer a cooperative purchasing agreement for the procurement of any goods, materials, equipment, or services with another local public procurement unit. A "local procurement unit" is defined as:

- any political subdivision, public authority, educational, health, or other institution; and to the extent provided by law, any other entity, including a council of governments or an area government; nonprofit fire, rescue or ambulance company; and any nonprofit cooperation operating a charitable hospital; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby deemed to be in the best interest of Berwick Township, to participate in LP3 State Piggyback program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the members of Berwick Township that Berwick Township will participate in PACC Automotive and Equipment Contract, by purchasing supplies and services from the contract based upon the terms and conditions of the contract and at the same prices. Further, Berwick Township will be responsible for the payment of the price directly to the contractor of said expenses directly related.
