ORDINANCE NO. 79

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BERWICK, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REGARDING THE BERWICK TOWNSHIP'S NON-POLICE PENSION PLAN, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 53.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desire to enact an amendment to the Berwick Township Non-Police Pension Plan, Ordinance No. 53;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Berwick Township as follows:

SECTION I.

Section 4. Vesting. of Ordinance No. 53 is hereby amended to state:

<u>Section 4. Vesting</u> Said pension benefits shall vest 100% after five (5) years of continuous service as an employee for the Township and said employee shall be entitled thereto on retirement at age 65, but cannot receive any such benefits until at least age 65.

SECTION II. SEVERANCE CLAUSE

Should any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of said Ordinance shall not be affected thereby, and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III. REPEALER CLAUSE

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the adoption hereof.
